The successful candidate will play a pivotal role in building upon the school's rapid recent development in netball and in furthering our ambition to establish Stowe School as a centre of excellence in the sport.

#### Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

- To promote the aims of the Group at all times with colleagues, parents, pupils and the public
- To play a full part in seven day a week boarding Schools with commitment to teaching, pastoral care, extra-curricular activities and School duties.
- To assist in the recruitment of pupils and to promote the Schools and Departments.
- To provide professional high quality teaching/coaching, with the effective use of appropriate resources and the highest standards of learning and achievement of all pupils.
- To attend all appropriate Health & Safety (COSHH) and Child Protection training issues related to the pupils, Schools and Departments.

#### **Key Tasks**

- To coach sports as required in the games and activities programme as directed by the Head of Netball and Director of Sport.
- To attend matches and tournaments
- Assist the department with various other large Sporting events happening throughout the year
- To help with the analysis process for your sport and assist where appropriate with others
- To develop links with Academies and local schools.
- Specialist 1-1 and group coaching for selected pupils and sports.
- Educate pupils in their understanding of sports and athletic development principles whilst providing opportunities to develop a rounded athletic skillset and sports specific physical qualities.
- Assist with the delivery of specific Sports Scholar (Performance Programme) development sessions.
- Provide the Sports Department with basic administrative support including SOCS /Website updates alongside match day set up and take down for School fixtures.
- To be a role model to pupils through personal presentation and professional conduct.
- To help with the process of identifying talent.
- To give regular and detailed feedback to players
- To assist with the netball and other sports S&C programmes.

- To ensure the registration of pupils for practices during afternoon activities.

- To assist the Director of Sport in the delivery of the Sports Scholarship programme.
