The Stowe Group

The Stowe Group of schools (Stowe, Ashfold, Swanbourne House and Winchester House) is situated on four separate sites in Buckinghamshire and Northamptonshire and educates children from 3-18 years. Within The Stowe Group there are more than 1,800 pupils and 800 members of staff. The schools occupy sites of historical significance in Swanbourne, Dorton, Brackley and the worldfamous landscape gardens at Stowe, where we work with The National Trust to manage 880 acres and open the grounds to over 200,000 visitors a year. Stowe House is open to the public during the School holidays and for guided tours during term time. The Stowe Group is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff to share this commitment. In 2021, The Stowe Group launched its transformational Change Makers vision and Change 100 programme.

Key Tasks:

- 1. To prepare surfaces ahead of decoration to ensure a high-quality finish.
- 2. To carry out decoration both internally and externally to all school buildings and structures as directed by the Decorating Foreman.
- 3. To carry out work in compliance with best trade practices, in accordance with the School's Health & Safety policies and rules and statutory regulations.
- 4. To comply with the Health & Safety data sheets for the materials used.
- 5. To work closely with other trades and members of the Estates Department in the completion of maintenance work, building works and refurbishment as directed by the Assistant Estates Manager.
- 6. To carry out work to a high standard, ensuring the workplace is safe and clean and tidy.
- 7. To ensure that the painters' workshop and store are kept clean and tidy.
- 8. To assist the Decorating Foreman in ensuring that stocks of building materials in store are maintained at minimum workable levels.
- 9. To check that fuel, oil, water, lights and tyres of School vehicles are in working order prior to use and to ensure vehicles are left clean after use. Any faults or accidents to be reported immediately to the Building and Works Manager.
- 10. To respect the surrounding and adjacent buildings and their fabric and finishes and ensure that the effect of the work is minimised on the other occupants of the School. Additionally, when leaving the works during the day and at the end of the working day, to ensure that works are left safe to ensure that other users of the building, including pupils, cannot be harmed by the building works.
